



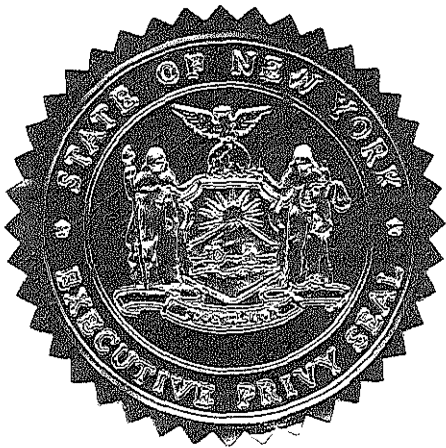

### PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, a vacancy exists in the office of Member of the United States House of Representatives from the twenty-fifth Congressional District, including parts of Monroe County, caused by the passing of Louise Slaughter;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Andrew M. Cuomo, Governor of the State of New York, pursuant to Section 42 of the Public Officers Law, do hereby order and proclaim that an election for Member of the United States House of Representatives in the place and for the unexpired term of Louise Slaughter be held in the said Congressional District on the sixth of November, two thousand eighteen, such election to be conducted in the manner prescribed by law for election of Members of the United States House of Representatives of the State of New York.
